Douglas County acknowledges that a property owner may desire to modify parcel(s) for tax purposes. As a result of changing land for tax purposes, the new parcel may not meet requirements of the County's **Unified Development Code (UDC)**. In order for any such request to be granted, all of the following must be true:

- Deed work and surveys must be recorded with the Douglas County Clerk of Superior Court.
- When combining parcels, title to all parcels must be held in the exact same name.
- All parcels must be contiguous and located in the same tax district (either city or county).
- No more than one dwelling may be located on one parcel of land.
- Property must meet the legal lot requirements for that area.
- Prior approval from the Douglas County Appraisal Department must be given before splitting or combining parcels that are in the conservation use covenant. Failure to do so could result in a large penalty
- Outstanding taxes must be paid before any new split or combine can be approved
